With this letter, I am forwarding the proposed one-year contract and work plan for FY12. As we have previously discussed, this represents an interim measure while we continue to work together to revamp the Environmental Service Delivery contracting process.

The workplans were previously e-mailed to each Local Health Officer and Environmental Director to assure that content was acceptable. We received an e-mail back from Steve Jenkins that your Department had looked it over and was okay with your workplan.

The total funding allotment for Southwest Utah District Health Department for FY2012 is \$111,559. This represents:

- Increased radon funding from \$400.00 to \$1,000.00 for outreach purposes. Our radon program contacted each Local Health Department to determine interest in this funding and Southwest expressed its interest.
- All other funding remains the same.


