With this letter, I am forwarding the proposed one-year contract and work plan for FY13. The total funding allotment Tri-County Health Department for FY13 is \$74,975. This represents:

- Reinstating the Used Oil funds at \$10,160.
- Reinstating the radon funding at \$500. As we discussed at the last Local Health Officer Meeting, EPA has indicated that it is cutting the Radon grant funding however, we wanted to continue it in FY13 and then see if we could find a way to fund it in the future.
- All other funding and requirements remains the same.

Funding and adjustments become effective July 1, 2012. Annual reports on current fiscal year work are due by August 31, 2012. As we did last year, an e-mail with the simplified reporting form will be sent out in late July.

Please review these documents and, if you are in agreement, sign and return them. If you have concerns, let Renette Anderson know and she will work with you to resolve them.
