

The Following document is a compilation of the original PM10 SIP conditions for a group of sources that will no longer be specifically regulated in SIP Section IX. Part H.2.

As discussed in chapter 10 of the SIP narrative for Salt Lake County, contingency measures in a maintenance plan shall include a requirement that the State will implement all control measures which were contained in the SIP prior to redesignation.

Where such source is still operational, these original conditions are herein identified as potential candidates for contingency measures in the event they are ever needed.
