Dear Petroleum Distributor:

Enclosed is a list of underground storage tank facilities in Utah that have had their Certificates of Compliance lapse due to non-payment of their fees, or have had the certificates revoked due to non-compliance. This list is also available on the internet at <http://www.undergroundtanks.utah.gov>, under the "What's New" section and will be updated monthly. Until such time as the owners or operators are re-issued a new Certificate of Compliance, these tanks cannot receive product.

Statutory penalties apply to the petroleum distributor for each delivery into each tank that does not have a current years tag. Please note that some of the facilities that have had their certificates revoked or lapsed may still have current or prior year tags displayed. This list will serve to inform you of the change in status of the tags at these facilities.

The list is sorted by county, which is indicated in the first column. Only facilities with tanks that were once certified and have since been lapsed or revoked have been included. New installations still require a one-time delivery authorization letter for any delivery made before the tags are posted. Please pass this list to all your drivers and other pertinent personnel.
