PUBLIC NOTICE TO REISSUE A UPDES PERMIT

PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE

The purpose of this public notice is to declare the state of Utah's intention to issue a Utah Pollutant Discharge elimination system (UPDES) permit under authority of the Utah water pollution control act, section 19-5-104(9) and 107(2), Utah code annotated 1953, as amended. said "permit" refers to the UPDES permit and the fact sheet statement of basis (including total maximum daily loads (tmdl's)) if applicable, as per section 303(d) of the federal clean water act (cwa)].

BACKGROUND

The Geneva facility is a now defunct integrated steel mill located in the town of Vineyard Utah, east of Utah Lake. The former steel making machinery has been dismantled and shipped off site, and all of the buildings on the property have been demolished. Currently the only treatment units operating include the RCRA Granular Activated Carbon Treatment Unit and the discharge of groundwater and storm water. Remediation of the property is ongoing.
