SECURITY PLAN

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The entire active portion of the facility shall be enclosed with a six-foot high chain link fence, topped with barbed wire. The fence layout is shown in Attachment II-1, Site Drawings. The fence line shall be maintained in good repair to prevent access underneath the fence that might develop due to erosion. Access through the Main Gate is provided by personnel in the Waste Receiving office. Communication to the Waste Receiving office is available with citizen band radio, cell phone, or a telephone located adjacent the main gate.

Gates are located strategically around the compound perimeter and shall be kept locked when unattended or not observable by facility or contract personnel.

Lighting shall be located throughout key areas of the facility in order to facilitate inspection by facility personnel and safe processing of wastes.

The Grassy Mountain Facility is located in the sparsely populated Great Salt Lake Desert, with the nearest residence located approximately 35 miles away. Access to the facility is from the south via a county road with access to Interstate 80.

Signs with the words **“DANGER – UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL KEEP OUT”** shall be posted on the gates and the fence-line of the facility perimeter. The signs shall be in English and posted at intervals of no more than 120 feet. They shall be legible from a distance of at least 25 feet and shall be observable from any approach to the facility.
