The Director of the Division of Waste Management and Radiation Control is seeking public comment on a request for a treatment variance received from the Clean Harbors Grassy Mountain Facility, LLC for a waste with Waste Code D009. The waste stream is spray dryer residue from the Clean Harbors Aragonite facility that contains mercury.

The public comment period to receive comments on the variance request will commence on October 1, 2015 and will end on October 30, 2015.
