The Director of the Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is proposing to enter into a STIPULATION AND CONSENT ORDER with Emerald Services, Inc. to resolve Notice of Violation Number 1307015 issued to Emerald on April 24, 2013 for violations of its used oil permits and the applicable used oil rules (R315-15 of the Utah Administrative Code). Emerald is a used oil processor, transporter, transfer facility and marketer operating at 2450 South 800 West, Salt Lake City, Utah 84119.

The public comment period to receive comments on the proposed SCO will commence on June 11, 2015 and end on July 10, 2015.
