PUBLIC NOTICE OF REISSUANCE OF A UPDES PERMIT

PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE

THE PURPOSE OF THIS PUBLIC NOTICE IS TO DECLARE THE STATE OF UTAH'S INTENTION TO REISSUE A UTAH POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (UPDES) PERMIT UNDER AUTHORITY OF THE UTAH WATER QUALITY ACT, SECTION 19-5-104 AND 107, UTAH CODE ANNOTATED 1953, AS AMENDED. SAID "PERMIT" REFERS TO UPDES PERMIT AND THE STATEMENT OF BASIS (INCLUDING THE TOTAL MAXIMUM DAILY LOADS (TMDL'S)) IF APPLICABLE, AS PER SECTION 303 (d) OF THE FEDERAL CLEAN WATER ACT (CWA).

BACKGROUND

Hexcel manufactures carbon fibers, epoxy resins, uni-directional carbon graphite cloth and woven carbon graphite fiber epoxy resin impregnated cloth ("pre-preg"). The wastewater generated on-site is discharged at Outfall 001 and consists of carbon fiber rinse water, reverse osmosis reject water, pump sealing cooling water, cooling tower blow down, steam condensate and non-contact cooling water. These waters are collected at the point of generation and then flow via an underground pipeline to the West Ridge Golf Course Pond or the Utah and Salt Lake Canal.
