PUBLIC NOTICE TO REISSUE A UPDES PERMIT

PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE

THE PURPOSE OF THIS PUBLIC NOTICE IS TO DECLARE THE STATE OF UTAH'S INTENTION TO ISSUE A UTAH POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (UPDES) PERMIT UNDER AUTHORITY OF THE UTAH WATER POLLUTION CONTROL ACT, SECTION 19-5-104(9) AND 107(2), UTAH CODE ANNOTATED 1953, AS AMENDED. SAID "PERMIT" REFERS TO THE UPDES PERMIT AND THE FACT SHEET STATEMENT OF BASIS (INCLUDING TOTAL MAXIMUM DAILY LOADS (TMDL'S)) IF APPLICABLE, AS PER SECTION 303(D) OF THE FEDERAL CLEAN WATER ACT (CWA)].

BACKGROUND

The facility serves the City of Provo with an average design flow of 21 MGD, and a design population equivalent of 160,000. The facility is located at 1685 South East Bay Boulevard in Provo City, Utah County, Utah, latitude 40° 12' 45" and longitude 111° 39' 00", with STORET Number 499656. The permit has Biosolids, Multi-Sector Storm water and Pretreatment components. One of the two mechanical influent bar screens was converted to a fine screen device. This change to the process was made because of constant repairs and the fine screen adds improved screening to the treatment process.
