PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE

THE PURPOSE OF THIS PUBLIC NOTICE IS TO SOLICIT PUBLIC COMMENT REGARDING SALT LAKE CITY'S INTENTION TO MODIFY ITS PRETREATMENT REGULATIONS REGARDING ITS SEWER ORDINANCE. THIS IS A RE-PUBLIC NOTICE DUE TO COMMENT THAT WERE RECEIVED DURING THE PERVIOUS PUBLIC NOTICE. THE CHANAGES TO THE ORDINANCE WILL BE THE ONLY PARTS OPEN FOR COMMENT SINCE THIS IS A RE-PUBLIC NOTICING. THE CHANGES ARE NOTED IN THE ORDIANCE AND CAN BE FOUND AT THE DIVISION OF WATER QUALITY'S WEB PAGE OR BY REQUEST. THE SEWER ORDINANCE HAS BEEN REVIEWED AND ONCE THE RE-PUBLIC NOTICE AND COMMENT PROCESS ARE COMPLETED; IT IS THE DIVISION OF WATER QUALITY'S INTENTION TO FORMALLY APPROVE THE MODIFICATIONS TO THE SEWER ORDINANCE.
