PUBLIC NOTICE OF RENEWAL OF A UPDES PERMIT

**PURPOSE OF PUBLIC NOTICE**

THE PURPOSE OF THIS PUBLIC NOTICE IS TO DECLARE THE STATE OF UTAH'S INTENTION TO RENEW A UTAH POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (UPDES) PERMIT UNDER AUTHORITY OF THE UTAH WATER QUALITY ACT, SECTION 19-5-104 AND 107, UTAH CODE ANNOTATED 1953, AS AMENDED. SAID "PERMIT" REFERS TO UPDES PERMIT AND THE STATEMENT OF BASIS (INCLUDING THE TOTAL MAXIMUM DAILY LOADS (TMDL'S)) IF APPLICABLE, AS PER SECTION 303 (d) OF THE FEDERAL CLEAN WATER ACT (CWA).

**BACKGROUND**

Tooele City Wastewater Treatment Plant (Tooele) serves a population equivalent of 17,000. The renewal permit includes biosolids and storm water and Reuse provisions, along with the standard permit. Tertiary treatment is required to meet Type 1 Reuse requirements. Biosolids are hauled to an offsite facility located at the Tooele County landfill where 100% of the biosolids are composted.
