This is happening after 15 years of environmental successes towards our first long term goals (dubbed *Vision Goals*). We are proud to set the bar high, for our industry and any industry, and look forward to continuing to work with Clean Utah to report on our goals, projects, successes and lessons learned.

Zion Lodge’s Vision Goals and Results (Baseline 2000), results shown have not been normalized, though it’s important to note that over that same 15 year period the Lodge increased revenue by 110%.

Our public participation for 2015 is as follows:

- Continue with ISO 14001 certification
- Continue with Green Seal Gold certification
- Work to attain LEED-EBOM certification (anticipated for 2016)
- Offer free electric vehicle charging for all guests and visitors
- Participate in Springdale Earth Day celebration (served on Planning Committee)
- Serve as Secretary for the Southern Utah Recycling Coalition – a group of public and privately concerned organizations working to improve access to recycling in the Southern-most 5 counties in Utah
- Serve on Zion National Park Green Team – a group of concerned Park employees and partners working together to complete hard-to-achieve projects
- Participate in Springdale Green Coalition – a group of business working together to share best management practices in the sustainable arena
- Hosted a “Fix-a-Leak” Week to support the EPA’s program
- Created and implemented a program from our Retail operation which collects \$0.05 for every bag a customer refuses. These funds were donated to the Springdale Rotary Club in their quest to install water bottle filling stations at the Springdale Shuttle Stops (approximately \$2000 in 2015) – program to continue in 2016.
